

**The Regulation of the Dean of the Faculty of Health Sciences,  
Vincent Pol University in Lublin, Poland**

**No. 1/2017/2018 of 13 April 2018**

**on the procedure of verification of originality of diploma theses by  
means of antiplagiarism software**

1. Diploma theses, defended in the Faculty of Health Sciences of Vincent Pol University in Lublin, shall be subject to verification by means of anti-plagiarism software.
2. Students are obliged to complete this anti-plagiarism verification on their own, in the anti-plagiarism system (<https://plagiat.pl/en/>), print out a verification report and submit it to their Supervisor.

Acceptable similarity coefficients should be the following:

Similarity coefficient No. 1  $\leq 50$

Similarity coefficient No. 2  $\leq 5$

3. If plagiarism has not been detected, the Supervisor prepares a decision on admission to diploma exam/defense – Attachment No. 1, and, subsequently, the student submits diploma thesis to the Dean's Office (hard copy/paper version, electronic version, report and Supervisor's decision on admission to diploma exam)
4. If the upper limit of similarity coefficient is exceeded, the Supervisor shall prepare the opinion – Attachment No. 2 to this regulation, and the Dean or the Vice-Dean of the Faculty makes a decision on admission to diploma exam after making appropriate corrections, or on refusal to approve the thesis.
